

No record of any good belonging to Shigeoka being found by Custodian, any place.

Mino Shigeoka, as occupier of 358 Cordova St., signed list of goods reported by her husband, on or around April 17, 1942. Mrs. Shigeoka's signature appears on sheet which reads, "I acknowledge holding the articles above described for safe custody and undertake to account for same to the Custodian on behalf of the above named Japanese"

Mino Shigeoka, evacuated June 29, 1942, declared no property in JP signed May 2, 1942.

November 3, 1942, Custodian to Heishiro Shigeoka, informs Shigeoka that the Custodian had been unable to trace the personal effects declared as being left at 358 Cordova Street. No reply from Shigeoka.

JP shows that Shigeoka rented 3 rooms at 358 Cordova from Mr. Fujioka, 358 E. Cordova. Rent paid to end of March, according to Mino Shigeoka's JP of May 2, 1942.

Seiichi FUJIOKA, File 11383, was evacuated August 25, 1942. He signed a JP on July 14, 1942, stating that he owned no chattels and that his landlord's name & address was unknown. 358 E. Cordova was not Japanese-owned, according to our records.

Mrs. Fujioka and her son, evacuated on September 16, 1942, declared no property.

As Mr. Shigeoka did not reply to Custodian letter of November 3, 1942, it was assumed that he or his wife had disposed of the goods he declared.

Komura Bros. filed claim for \$6.14 due from Heishiro Shigeoka. Shigeoka sent funds to settle this account on April 11, 1944, through Dept. of Labour.
