The only asset declared by the above Japanese when registering with this office was a \$1000.00 Term Life Insurance policy. This policy was not brought under control or administered in any way by the Custodian.

Mrs. MIYOSHI declared she owed the Royal Columbian Hospital the sum of \$36.20, and this claim, which according to the hospital amounted to \$36.22, was paid from the joint account of the Japanese and her husband. The money in the joint account was derived from Monarch Life Insurance Company cheque payable to Masao MIYOSHI, the assured and Midori MIYOSHI, the beneficiary, jointly, and has been remitted.

Two other claims were filed against Mr. & Mrs. MIYOSHI, one by Dr. Morse for \$10.00 which was found to have already been paid, and the other by Kiyozo ODA which was denied and was later found to be against Miyoshi ODA.

This file needs no further administration and may now be closed.
