Chattels on file 9587 seem to be covered by statement dated May 12th, 1943.

It appears from file 7358 that some of the items in the basement belong to Tanejiro Hayashida. Those originally inventoried on July 16th, 1942, as belonging to Tanejiro Hayashida, do not now appear (so far as can be seen) on the inventory of Kiujiro Kusano's things on his file dated May 12th, 1943. This may be due to their being moved by the owners before evacuation or by the tenants to other parts of the house.

Tanejiro Hayashida has now applied for shipment of some of his belongings left with Kiujiro Kusano and it seems reasonable that these be shipped.

Finally, it appears that there may also be at Kiujiro Kusano's place, some small items belonging to Kiyonobu Nishimura, file 5756, shipment of which has also been applied for.
