GENERAL SUMMARY

File No. 7450

December 11, 1946.

Re: Yasunosuke SUGAYA #00290

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 1, 1942. He was evacuated on September 23, 1942.

In his declaration, SUGAYA stated that he owned no property of any kind in the protected area. No real property is revealed by his file. Chattels located at 914 Davis Street were declared by Hatsu SUGAYA, wife of this man, whose file is No. 12961, and these are dealt with in her file.

Mrs. Hatsu SUGAYA reported ownership of four shares of stock in the Associated Cleaners & Dyers Ltd. The file of that company does not show the name of Mrs. Hatsu SUGAYA as a shareholder, but does show that Yasunosuke was the owner of four shares of stock. The records show 169 shares of stock owned by various shareholders.

The Associated Cleaners & Dyers Ltd. is being liquidated by the shareholders. Liquidation is being handled by Walker A. Jacklin & Company, chartered accountants. On January 16, 1946, there were in the hands of Walter A. Jacklin & Company funds to the amount of \$14,000.00 and other assets amounting to \$5,100.00 (plus interest) was being paid to Walter A. Jacklin & Company at the rate of \$200.00 a month.

On May 1, 1946, distribution of funds on the basis of \$60.00 a share was made to the shareholders. From this distribution the sum of \$240.00 was sent direct to Yasunosuke SUGAYA. On May 28, 1946, a further distribution of funds was made on the basis of \$30.00 a share, and \$120.00 was to be sent direct to SUGAYA from this distribution. It is evident that further distributions will be made to the shareholders. Unless something occurs that necessitates a change in the manner of handling the funds, future distributions of funds will be sent direct to SUGAYA.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

This file reveals that the claim filed against Yasunosuke SUGAYA by Dr. N. Uchida was withdrawn. The amount of the claim was \$50.50.

The file of Mrs. Hatsu SUGAYA reveals a claim of \$62.00 filed by Ichiro NAKATSUKA, File 10884, and another claim is reported by the Department of Labour, Japanese Division (dental treatment) in the amount of \$97.83. There is a credit balance of \$337.50 in Mrs. SUGAYA's ^{acc.} which is sufficient to cover her liabilities.

This summary is certified to be in accordance with information on file.

MEMORANDUM TO FILE

July 23rd, 1945.

FROM: Mrs. McArthur.

The Associated Cleaners & Dyers Ltd. is in process of voluntary liquidation by Walter A. Jacklin & Co. Mr. Jacklin advises that the evacuee shareholders have all been circularized in this connection, and it is anticipated that the proceeds from the liquidation will be distributed before very long.

The assets of this Company are worth in the neighbourhood of \$16,000.00, and each share valued at about \$60.00. This evacuee owns four(4) shares.
