2. On this date the writer interviewed a Japanese at 450 Bathurst St., Toronto, Ontario, who claimed to be Ichiro IDENOME. In verification he produced a Buff coloured Japanese Registration Card #14412, issued in the above mentioned name at Larita Bay, B.C., as well as a National Registration Certificate issued in the same name at 231 Main St., Vancouver, B.C. At the request of the writer, this Japanese signed his name several times. These signatures appeared somewhat similar to those on the two cards of identification previously mentioned, however these previous signatures were written approximately 10 years ago. It is believed by the writer that this is the subject in question.
