

MEMORANDUM - MR. WRIGHT

Re: The late Mr. Toshio FUKUDA

Mrs. Tsugiko Fukuda, Reg. No. 14157, File No. 7348, is the widow of Toshio Fukuda who died after January 25, 1940 and before May 1, 1942. Toshio Fukuda was not evacuated and was not registered with the Custodian.

Real estate in Nancy is still in the name of Toshio Fukuda having a value assessed for purposes of tax of \$1,500.00; the land has been vested in the Custodian.

As far as we know, the late Mr. Toshio Fukuda is survived not only by his wife but by four children aged eleven, nine, six and four and by his father, Tomozo Fukuda, aged 70.

You will find attached letter dated June 23rd from Mr. Yamaga together with holographic will in Japanese signed by Tomozo Fukuda and Sedakichi Abe, Sedakichi Abe being the father of the widow Tsugiko Fukuda. The will has been translated by Mr. Yamaga.

Would you please be good enough to advise me as to the steps to be taken for clearing title to the land in accordance with terms of the will.
