Although Mrs. SHISHIDO declared on May 4th, 1942, that she owed no personal property, another Japanese person, Kino NIKAIDO, file 7568, declared on July 29th, 1942, that 2 crates stored with J.W. Berry Ltd., 1206 Homer Street, were the property of T. SHISHIDO.


The two crates containing furniture were removed to Custodian storage 992 Powell St., and subsequently sold at auction in Vancouver on August 9th, 1944, the net sum realized - \$10.41, being credited to Toku SHISHIDO, as per sales sheets on file. Mrs. SHISHIDO and Mrs. NIKAIDO originally had their effects at 2095 West 7th Ave., Vancouver, B.C.

LIFE INSURANCE:

Mrs. SHISHIDO declared she owned a Sun Life Assurance Co., policy 62237727, for \$1000.00, the beneficiary being her son, Wataru. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.
