Mrs. Toda made a declaration of her effects which were stored by her at Lims Store, Fraser Mills, in general terms. However under dates of 24/9/42 and 3/12/42 she sent the Custodian an itemized list of her belongings. These were not checked in their entirety by our Agents in New Westminister, although some items were listed by them on 27/5/42 and 27/9/42. Fuller particulars are shown on the Chattel Schedule. On May 27/43 and Sept 9/43, 7 boxes, a basket 3 hoses and 3 shovels were shipped to Mrs Toda by B.C.S. Commission. The balance of her effects were removed by the Custodian to the New Westminister Auction rooms and sold on Aug. 30/44, realizing the net sum of \$24.75 which was credited to Mrs. Toda as per sales sheets on file. 6 small boxes were missing and several pieces of Home made and obsolete furniture were abandoned.

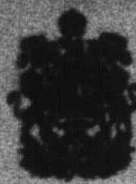
