



Mrs Gensaku (Kino) NIKAIDO declared on May 4th, 1942 that she had no property in the Protected Area of British Columbia, but later, on July 29th, 1942, stated on a signed memorandum that she had stored with J.W. Berry Ltd., 1206 Homer St., Vancouver, 2 crates marked with her name and 2 crates marked T. SHISIDO. All of these crates were recovered by the Custodian on October 1st, 1943 and the contents sold, the sales proceeds - \$12.18 of Mrs. NIKAIDO'S effects being credited to her and those of Mrs. SHISIDO to her account, File 7522.


