

No doubt the husband at Midway would immediately bring the camera to his home in Greenwood and leave it there. He is listed as living at Midway but actually his home is in Greenwood although he goes to work at Midway through the week.

This means the Ebata family are residents of Greenwood, and the policy still is no camera or radios to Japanese in Housing Centres whether they be self-supporting or not. If the policy should ever be changed, we will advise him.
