This file reveals that Mrs. FUKUYAMA did not own any real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

Mrs. FUKUYAMA made her declaration to the Custodian on May 1/42 and was evacuated on May 5/42. She declared no chattels. However shipping bills on file reveal that shipments were made to her on March 17/42 and March 27/42, all costs being paid by her.

LIFE INSURANCE:

She declared the following policies:

Monarch Life Insurance Co. in the sum of \$1000.00
Prudential Life in the name of Hidekazu FUKUYAMA - \$250.00
Prudential Life in the name of Yuriko FUKUYAMA - \$250.00


We were advised by the Mutual Life that she had a policy with them. None of these were brought under the control of the Custodian.

According to information on file Iwakichi SUGIYAMA and Senkichi FUKUYAMA were the sole shareholders in the Burrard Fish Co. This company was the beneficiary under Monarch Life Policy No. P83305 on the life of Rikimatsu TABATA (now deceased). Rikimatsu TABATA was the father of Mrs. Hideko FUKUYAMA. The two shareholders of the Burrard Fish Co. signed a release transferring their rights and interest in this policy to Hideko FUKUYAMA (nee TABATA). We have now received a cheque in the sum of \$792.45 from the Monarch Co. being in full settlement of all claims under this policy. This cheque is made payable to the beneficiary, Hideko FUKUYAMA. They also enclosed with the cheque discharge papers which could be completed if the beneficiary could not personally endorse the cheque. These however will not be necessary. This cheque is being remitted to her today.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.


