Re: Policy #262,503 - on the lives of
Minoru & Gissku Serizawa

We wish to thank you for your letter of February 19th
with the enclosure noted.

We believe that a few similar surrender and loan cheques
are delivered to policyholders through your office, and we felt
for your protection as well as our own we should make it clear
that our practice, in line with that followed by all other com-
panies, is to get the necessary papers signed before releasing
the necessary cheque.

I do hope that you will not interpret this letter as a
rebuke, but merely as an attempt to clarify our procedure for
future purposes. We have, on occasion, been inclined to deviate
from the Company's rigid regulation, but have found that the
very person for whom you make an exception turns out to be the
one in ten whose cooperation cannot always be depended upon.
This sometimes leads to a great deal of embarrassing correspon-
dence, and our rule has been adopted in the hope of avoiding
that embarrassment.
