We thank you for your letter of the 29th ultimo, and in compliance with your request, we are discarding the books.

Your file has now come under review and the following is noted.

Your declaration to the Custodian dated May 5th, 1942, indicates that you owned certain household effects which were left at 501 Bevan Avenue, New Westminster. The bulk of these goods were sold at auction as per copies of sales sheets sent to you on February 16th, 1945. Your bed, spring, mattress and baby crib complete, were shipped to you on July 6th, 1943.

Your account with Dr. Purviss in the sum of \$20.50 was paid for you through this office on October 16th, 1945, in accordance with your request. The balance now standing to your credit on our books is \$23.67, and a cheque for this amount is enclosed herewith.



Mrs. Tomiya SHUTO declared on May 5/42 that she owned certain household effects left in the house at 501 Ewen Avenue, New Westminster. Mrs. SHUTO was evacuated May 15/42 and under date of Nov. 20/42 an inventory of the chattels found by our agents at this address was submitted to her and confirmed on Nov. 20/42.

On July 6/43 a baby crib and 1 double spring mattress was delivered to Belyea & Co., New Westminster, for shipment to Mrs. SHUTO.

Preparatory to an auction of Japanese goods, certain effects belonging to the above Japanese were removed to our auction rooms in New Westminster and Surrey, and sold under dates of April 21/44, and April 12/45, realizing the net sum of \$44.17 as shown in our auction sheets on file. The proceeds were credited to the account of Mrs. SHUTO.

There remains in our storage warehouse at the Buddhist Temple, New Westminster, 1 box of books. All chattels disclosed have now been accounted for and our administration in this respect is completed.
