CHATELS:

On his "JP" Form of April 22/42 Mr. Yamashita listed certain chattels left at his residence at Wood and Salter Sts., New Westminster. (see attached schedule).

On May 5/42 Mrs. Yamashita listed the chattels to be left at the same address on her "JP" Form. This list is at variance with that of her husbands.

On August 10/42 when our fieldman had these effects moved to storage an inventory was taken. A copy of this inventory was later signed by Mr. and Mrs. Yamashita and is on file. All usable goods were later sold at auction and the net proceeds of \$54.29 was forwarded to Mr. and Mrs. Yamashita.

Other chattels left at 1564 Townline Road were also listed on "JP" Form of April 22/42 but these we have been unable to trace. (see attached memo).

The disposal of Yamashita's float house, Net house float and float wharf, are dealt with on a separate personal property summary.

Kolarcik of April 5/42. There is no evidence of the disposition of these chattels, nor is there any record of their removal to storage.

Harumi KAWASOYE who operated the farm at 1564 Towline Road, and owned several buildings on the property, left a quantity of effects at this address, consequently there is considerable doubt as to proper ownership of the chattels under review.
