Would you please be good enough to refer to our letter to you dated May 20th. and to the letter to you from Mr. H. P. Scott dated May 13, 1943, regarding the individuals mentioned above. Specifically in connection with belief expressed by Mr. Hanjiro Yoshijima that he was the owner of two \$500.00 Victory Bonds.

We have obtained the registration of his daughter, Haruye Yoshijima registration no. 08227 and note that she is residing in Kaslo also.

We suggest that Mr. Scott discuss the matter with both Mr. Yoshijima and with his daughter Miss. Yoshijima. We have provided you with everything known to the Custodian in connection with the bonds in question and propose to take no further action whatsoever.

In brief Mr. Yoshijima declared to us on May 5, 1942, that he was holding two \$50.00 Victory Bonds and one \$500.00 Victory Bond. His daughter did not admit holding any Victory Bonds. If Mr.

Thank you for your letter dated May 17th, enclosing copy of letter dated May 13th, from Mr. H. P. Scott, Local Treasury Officer in Esalo, B. C.

The facts of the matter are:

(1) Mr. Hanjiro YOSHIJIMA declared to the Custodian on May 5th, 1942, that he was holding in his possession two \$50.00 Victory Bonds and one \$500.00 Victory Bond. We have no record of the Bonds, nor do we know the numbers of them nor do we know to whom he entrusted them. All we have on file is Mr. Yoshijima's statement.

(2) Mr. Hanjiro YOSHIJIMA now states that the \$500.00 Bond belongs to his daughter and he thinks there should be two \$500.00 Bonds. This may or may not be correct, and we are unable to confirm the correctness at this time of the beliefs expressed by Mr. Yoshijima. One reason being that his daughter, Haruye YOSHIJIMA, Reg. 05227, has not registered with the Custodian. We are attempting to secure her registration and question her on behalf of her father and we will be happy to notify you further.

(3) Another daughter, Toyoko, aged twenty-three, also is not registered with the Custodian and her registration is being solicited.
