





This woman's first husband was Reizo or Reizo KUNIHIRO by whom she had three children. Reizo KUNIHIRO died prior to 1942 and she had one child by her next husband, Saekichi HOSHIGUCHI. The latter died before 1942.

She is now the common law wife of Eizaburo KOSUGI by whom she had one child.

The two younger children, Suyematsu and Sakai are declared by Mrs. Moto KUNIHIRO as her wards. Ota, Hideo and Kiyoshi KUNIHIRO made their own declarations under files 1696, 977 and 12696 respectively.

We thank you for your letter of August 26th, from which we note that the 'JP' forms mailed to your mother, Mrs. Reizo Kunihiro, have been sent to your brother Oto Kunihiro.

Please note that it is necessary for every member of your family to make out the 'JP' registration forms whether they own property or not. Therefore, you should not have sent these forms to your brother for he has already made out these forms and they are on our files. We also have 'JP' forms for Hideo Kunihiro and we must have these forms for Mrs. Reizo Kunihiro as well as for yourself if you are over sixteen. We therefore take this opportunity of enclosing six 'JP' forms, three for your mother and three for yourself, presuming that you are over sixteen years of age. Whether or not you own property or chattels, please fill out these forms in detail where they apply to you, and if you own no property, chattels, insurance, etc., you can state 'none'.

You can advise your brother Oto Kunihiro, that he need not make up those forms that you sent him as we have received his forms as stated above.

In your brother's file 'Oto Kunihiro', we have a list of chattels left behind and it was in this connection that we wrote to him for verification of these goods. This list was returned to us signed by him, but enclosed in a letter signed by Kiyoshi Kunihiro. Is this another member of your family who has not registered? If so, let us know and we will forward another set of registration forms if this member of your family is also over sixteen years of age.
