

The Bonded Credit Adjusters in New Westminster have filed a claim with us against you on behalf of Dr. Sinclair's estate and on behalf of Wr. A. C. Lessard. The claim against you of Dr. Sinclair's estate amounts to \$20.00, and on behalf of a note given to you by Mr. A. C. Lessard, \$21.79 is claimed, together with interest at the rate of 8% per annum. We would appreciate receiving your comments in connection with both claims as it occurs to us that if you agree with the correcteness of these claims you will desire to authorize or to effect settlement on your behalf from proceeds of War Savings Certificates having a face value of \$135,00 which, we understand, you have just arranged to have forwarded to Ottawa for redemption.
