We regret that we have no information whatsoever regarding this man's resources but our records indicate that Mideso Shiraishi, Registration No. 01939, reported to us on April 3rd, 1942, that he was sixty years old, was living at 757 East Hastings Street, that his wife's name is Kiwano, that he was, at the moment, unamployed, that he had been employed in the past by the B. C. Canadian Fish Company at Kimisket, B. C., that he had no assets, that he owed \$100.00 to a Wr. Kamin of 143 Donlevey Street, that he owed \$300.00 to a Mr. Wishimura of Vancouver and that he would be unable to pay these debts because of his unemployment and, finally, that his unemployment was due to illness.
