I am not quite clear about the position on these files and perhaps you will put a memorandum on them summarizing all transactions.

Apparently the property and some furnishings were purchased for \$2000.00 of which sum it was decided that \$200.00 should represent the price of the chattels involved and a Bill of Sale made out in that amount.

Subsequently a remittance of \$150.00 less certain expenses, was received, this being for a bedroom suite and other items additional to those included in the Bill of Sale.

I think that all the other items on the property, being those in the locked room and basement and including the items also declared by the wife, have been moved to the Queensborough United Church property where this office will no longer be concerned with them but I should like your confirmation of this.

Will you please advise if this cleans up all personal property on this file except those held by Mr. Grimmer, 4317 W. 15th Avenue, Vancouver, as per Form Letter 14 (2 copies) of December 11th.
