NOTE: A telephone call was received on November 22, 1946, from Mr. Howell, who does special work for the Custodian. He informed us that the Buddhist Temple had again been broken into and that all parcels of personal goods stored in the basement had been opened and the contents strewn on the floor. It is impossible to identify to whom they belong.

The personal effects that were salvaged on February 27, 1947, being 44 boxes and cartons, were removed to Vancouver and stored in a room in the basement of 604 East Cordova Street. These items cannot be identified by the office.

A suggestion was made by Aiheiji Kishi of Cascade, who helped to sort personal goods, that this office should forward these goods to Greenwood as many former residents of Steveston are now living there and they could most likely identify these items.
