Dear Madam:

We have written to you on numerous occasions in regard to the personal effects removed from 333 Beon Avenue and sold at auction. As there were three other persons besides yourself who declared they had left their effects at this address, it is not yet clear as to the ownership of these.

The storage at 333 Beon Avenue appears to have been a last minute affair as in no case did any person give the Custodian a list of their possessions and this office was therefore, quite in the dark as to what they were or to whom the goods belonged. Consequently, when our fieldman removed the saleable effects they simply took what they found, and as you have already been advised, credited the account of Yuichi KATAKAMI, the registered householder, with the sales proceeds.

We are sending a copy of this letter to all those persons interested and would suggest that the funds representing the proceeds from chattels auctioned be left in Mr. KATAKAMI'S account until you decide between yourselves as to its distribution.
