
Replying to your letter dated July 2nd,

Dear Sir:

Thank you very much for your telephone message of this morning regarding the fire which, on the night of June 30th, badly damaged the apartment house at 629½ East Cordova Street.

Upon checking our records we find that Mr. Iwazo Tanaka, registration #00702 declared to us on May 6th that he rented an apartment at 629½ East Cordova Street which he declared was the property of Mr. R. Uyeno of 600 Powell Street. We have no record of the registration of Mr. R. Uyeno but we have to-day written to Mr. Tanaka at Greenwood B. C. asking him to provide us with particulars of the full name of Mr. Uyeno and his present address. As soon as we hear further particulars regarding Mr. R. Uyeno we shall be glad to get in touch with you accordingly.

You also informed us on the telephone that on the night of June 30th fires had broken out at No. 605 and No. 629 East Cordova Street. We regret to inform you that we find we are unable to ascertain the names of the Japanese owners who may be involved in these two properties. Any information you are able to give us in this connection would be very much appreciated.

We understood you to say on the telephone that Mr. Louis Boyd was the owner of the property at 605 East Cordova Street.
