However, on November 17th, 1942, the Custodian advised her that the list sent was in error and a list of the effects tegged under her name in the Agnes ot. School was forwarded. This she did not acknowledge. This list omits D Room and B. Room sets, Plano and 2 stoves, and in a statement to the B.C. Security Commission Welfare manager at Easlo, Mrs. KAMEGAYA stated that the B. room and ". room sets must have been sold, altho" whether sold by herself or the Custodian was not clear. 
