MEMORANDUM

File: 15228

February 12, 1948

Re: Aiso HASEBE #37722

In JP declaration received from Aiso Hasebe on November 1, 1943, he reported "table kitchen wear, glass cabinet & shoe last in the hands of the Custodian" and shoe repairing equipment in storage with Ferguson Motor Transport Co. His wife, on May 6, 1942, had declared one dresser and one cabinet left at 107-10th St., New Westminster (premises formerly occupied by Yukio Hasebe brother of Aiso)

On April 1, 1944, this office passed on to Ferguson's Transport Co. the request received from Yukio Hasebe for shipment of all the goods in that storage. Shipment was to be made to Yukio and Aiso Hasebe, Kaslo, B.C. See list, Apr. 6/42, of goods stored.

Letter April 1, 1944, to Yukio Hasebe informs him that the storage company would be shipping the goods held by them. That this would account for all the effects of the family except for some items in New Westminster Buddhist Temple under the name of Mrs. Aiso Hasebe.

Although letter of April 1, 1944, refers to items under the name of Mrs. Aiso Hasebe being in Custodian storage, none of our records show goods in the name of that woman. The only explanation is that, in the letter, the name of Mrs. Aiso Hasebe was substituted for that of Mrs. Yukio Hasebe. There were goods in Custodian storage under the name of Mrs. Yukio Hasebe.

All the goods found at 107-10th St., New Westminster, were listed under the names of Mr. & Mrs. Yukio Hasebe. A list was sent to this couple who returned the list signed in acknowledgment of the goods listed being all their chattels left in the protected area. If any of the goods listed were the property of Mr. & Mrs. Aiso Hasebe, this was not brought to the attention of the Custodian by Mr. & Mrs. Yukio Hasebe.

Some of the goods found at 107-10th St. have been shipped to Mr. & Mrs. Yukio Hasebe. Saleable items remaining after shipments have been sold and the proceeds credited to the account of Mrs. Yukio Hasebe. (who has filed claim for loss in connection with personal effects).

In regard to the radio, the claim was the first record we had of this article.

It is not clear from the claim whether the kitchen goods and radio were in Ferguson Transport Co. storage or in the New Westminster Buddhist Temple. If they were in commercial storage, all have been shipped to the best of our knowledge. If in Custodian storage at New Westminster, they have been dealt with as being the property of Aiso Hasebe's brother and sister-in-law.

As requested in yours of March 22nd we have asked Ferguson Transport Company to ship to you and your brother at Kaslo the remaining items held by them. For our own records we would mention that these are shown as being in the name of Mrs. Aizo HASEBE. We would further mention that this seems to clear up the effects of your family in the protected area with the exception of a few items left in the New Westminster Buddhist Temple under the name of Mrs. Aizo HASEBE.

We have asked Messrs. Ferguson Transport Company to prepay the freight to your end and propose to charge this also to your account.

If you wish, we can move them to Custodian's storage but before doing so, it will be necessary to pay the amount at present owing, which by the time you answer this letter, will doubtless be \$12.00.
