

GENERAL SUMMARY

Takashi KIRIYAMA, Dec'd,

Reg. No. 11756.

Takashi KIRIYAMA died at New Denver, B. C. on September 1, 1945, at the age of twenty-three. He is survived by his father, Ryoichi, file No. 8199.

At the time of his registration, Takashi KIRIYAMA was only nineteen years of age and had no assets.

A claim by the Provincial Board of Health appears on the file but, from a telephone conversation with the Collector of Institutional Revenue, it is learned that this account was paid by the British Columbia Security Commission.

The Department of Labour made claim for recovery of the sum of \$80.00 to cover funeral expenses of the deceased. They were advised by this office on June 25, 1946, that Takashi KIRIYAMA had no assets whatsoever from which this claim could be paid.
