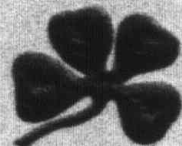

The claims by "B.C. Packers Ltd." and M. Teraguchi",  
\$916.26 & \$127.96 respectively, are substantially correct.

The above amounts are money borrowed by my father.  
When he (father) returned to Japan, he left me all the fish-  
ing equipment that he owned, with the understanding that I  
would pay off his debts.

However, because of the war, I was unable to pay off  
all of the principal, either by rental or sale of the said  
fishing equipment. I regret that at the present time, I am  
unable to settle the balance, of \$916.26 & \$127.96, that are  
still outstanding, either wholly or in part, as the wage that  
receiving at this camp does not permit me to do so.
