Dear Sir:

We thank you for yours of January 10th, 1946 inquiring as to what balance is lying to the credit of B. IWASA from account of chattel sales.

In replying we may advise that the amount placed to the credit of this account from the chattel sales was \$315.51. We must point out however, that there is a claim of \$82.75 registered against B. IWASA by the N. NISHIMUCHI Co. Ltd. for merchandise supplied in 1940, 1941, 1942. This concern states that they hold a demand note for the amount. As this liability has been acknowledged by you it will hold priority on the funds in our hands. However, you may be able to arrange a compromise with this company and will advise us immediately as to this.

In regards to your family pictures we will make an investigation and if they can be located we will be glad to mail them to you.
