
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:





The above Japanese made his declaration to the Custodian on May 6th, 1942 and was evacuated on May 13th, 1942.

He declared that he had no personal property whatsoever in the Protected Area.

RECEIVABLE:

A 1% wage deduction of \$4.76 for the first six months of 1941 was refunded by the Provincial Collector and remitted to Tomejiro FUJIWARA on January 18th, 1944.


LIFE
INSURANCE:

Although, this Japanese did not declare any insurance in his name, the Manufacturer's Life Insurance Company on December 11th, 1943 asked the Custodian's permission to pay him the cash surrender value of policy #716018. This was granted and the Insurance Company forwarded to this office a cheque in the amount of \$130.63 payable jointly to Tomejiro and Koichi FUJIWARA. The cheque was sent to K. FUJIWARA on March 9th, 1946.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
