Dear Sir:

We have a communication from the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, together with a copy of your letter to them dated September 19th, 1945, in which you request us to send you the proceeds from the sale of your effects.

You will recall that your stock in trade, left at 843 Columbia Street, New Westminster, was sold by tender and received your acceptance, the amount realized being \$190.00. Your other chattels and personal belongings were removed to our storage warehouse and subsequently sold at auction. We enclose herewith your auction sales sheets from which you will note the amount received for the different items. Your credit balance is \$150.83.

We note your request for your entire balance, but as there are still some outstanding claims on your file, we are just enclosing cheque for \$75.00 at this time.
