Dear Sir:

The above noted Japanese, who prior to evacuation resided at New Westminster, B. C., died on January 11, 1946, at Slocan City, B. C., and we have been advised by his widow, Mrs. Suemo Hayashida, that she has placed the administration of his Estate in your hands, and forwarded you an itemized list of particulars in connection therewith.

According to our records, the deceased and his widow were Naturalized Canadians. We have been advised by the R.C.M.P. that the oldest children, Takeshi Hayashida, aged 24, and Miyoshi Hayashida, aged 21, were born in Canada, and we therefore presume that the remaining six minor children were also born in this country. We believe their names, ages and addresses were included in the Memorandum of Particulars forwarded to you by Mrs. Hayashida.

The only asset of the deceased, of which we have knowledge, is a credit balance with the Custodian, amounting to \$186.10, but there may be a further small sum credited to his account from the sale of chattels.

Liabilities on file against the deceased are as follows:

1. Department of Labour, Japanese Division, account for funeral expenses - \$80.00.
2. N. Nishiguchi Company Limited - \$232.32, for merchandise supplied prior to evacuation and during the years 1940, 1941 and 1942. N. Nishiguchi Company Limited have advised us that they hold a Promissory Note, dated May 2, 1942.

We note in the Memorandum of Particulars, forwarded to us by Mrs. Hayashida, that Miyoshi Hayashida, daughter, in Hamilton, Ontario, paid a portion of funeral expenses, and we presume this refers to \$55.00 paid to J. Draper of Slocan, B. C.

We would be pleased to have you advise us as to your willingness to act in this Estate, and when Letters of Administration have been granted to you, kindly forward a certified copy to this office, in order that we may remit the funds in our hands.
