The only transaction on our file is in regard to a cheque for \$2.60 received from the Insurance Company in December, 1943 in favour of Mrs. Murakami. The cheque was apparently forwarded to her, although there is no covering letter in our file. As far as we are aware, the Custodian has no interest in the policy.
