PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 8040

March 20, 1947.

RE: Katsuichi NAKASHIMA, Reg. No. 05308

This file reveals that NAKASHIMA owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

NAKASHIMA made his declaration to the Custodian on May 7/42 and was evacuated on June 5/42. He declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file at 983 Keefer St. When we wrote and advised him that no chattels belonging to him had been found at this address he replied on April 30/43 stating that his goods had been left at 943 Keefer St. He also said the only articles he had left at this address were the following:

2 double beds complete
8 chairs
1 box of plain plates.

The property at 943 Keefer St. was owned by Seitaro SUGAMORI and all the goods from there were sold in his name. Mr. Dusenbery administered this file and he has transferred from the account of SUGAMORI to the account of NAKASHIMA, one bed and spring and 8 chairs, which were sold for the net sum of \$11.83. This leaves one bed and the box of plates not accounted for by the Custodian. As the chattels were mixed with those of others these goods may compare with those declared by the other Japanese and may have been credited to any of their accounts. At any rate the best division of the chattels possible has apparently been made.

MONEYS
RECEIVABLE:

On March 29/43 the account of NAKASHIMA was credited with the sum of \$6.72, being a refund of 1% wage deductions for the first six months of 1941.

His account was also credited with the sum of \$3.00, being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R.

WAR SAVINGS
CERTIFICATES:

He declared 16 \$10.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

BANK
ACCOUNT:

He declared an account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings in the sum of \$80.00. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

With further reference to memorandum of April 26th, the file of Seitaro Sugamori (11268) shows that we are having great difficulty in identifying the various belongings left at 943 Keefer Street. The correspondence is under way on file 11268 and other files, but will probably not produce any satisfactory results.

From letter of April 30th, 1943, on file 8040, and April 20th, 1943, on file 8414, it appears that the only effects belonging to these Japanese left at 943 Keefer Street as follows.

- 2 Double beds (no mattresses)
- 1 Small box of plain plates
- 8 Kitchen chairs

Reference to the auction list of April 18th on file 11268 shows sale of various beds, a carton of crockery, and eighteen kitchen chairs so that it is quite probable that the effects of these evacuees are included in the auction sale of Seitaro Sugamori's belongings, the proceeds of which have been frozen until the position is finally clarified.
