PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS:

The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on May 7/42 and was evacuated on May 20/42, declared household effects left at House #26 Imperial Cannery, where she lived with her brother M. YAMASHITA.

We wrote to the above on March 22/45 and asked her to let us know the name of her brother, whose first name started with "M". No reply was received to this letter.

On June 24/42 Custodian agent, Mr. W. C. Robinson, inventoried in the name of M. YAMASHITA, List #23, goods found at the Imperial Cannery boat house. This list is to be found on the file of Iwataro YAMASHITA, Internee File 1088. This list however does not contain any of the effects declared by the above, although they might have been declared by the brother, M. We cannot however locate any man of the name of "M. YAMASHITA" who lived in House #26, Imperial Cannery, and who declared chattels.

The file reveals the above owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

The above summary is certified to be in accordance with the information on file.
