Shori KIYONAGA lived at Cumberland, B. C. with his parents before Evacuation, at which time he was a logger for Royston Lumber Company. Evacuee now resides at Lemon Creek, Slokan, B. C.

Securities: Declared in his 'JP' Form dated May 7th 1942, "\$40.00 War Savings Certificates. In owner's possession."
The Custodian has no interest in the above-mentioned.

Above declared in letter dated September 26th 1944, having savings with the Royston Lumber Company, which were placed with the Royston Savings Association.
File shows:

25 shares with a par value of \$125.00 in Shori KIYONAGA's name.
Distribution was made to him of \$51.25, leaving a balance of \$73.75.
Distribution of Roystons Savings Surplus, \$13.78, making a balance of \$87.53 in the above-mentioned account. This amount has been forwarded to Shori KIYONAGA at his request and with the approval of the Department of Labour, Japanese Division.

No property interests other than those mentioned, are found on this file.

the welfare so the only place to depend

is for my savings. I'm crying and
