PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

File No. 8121

October 18, 1946.

Re: Tome FUJIMURA #09546

This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 4, 1942. She was evacuated on May 11, 1942.

In her declaration she reported a quantity of chattels, stored at the B. C. Pulp & Paper Co. Storage-house, Woodfibre, B. C. On May 6, 1942, the B. C. Pulp & Paper Co. supplied this office with an inventory of the goods stored in one of the company's buildings for Evacuees. The 2 stoves declared by Mrs. FUJIMURA are not on this inventory, and it is assumed that she disposed of these in some manner. It is assumed that the 2 boxes of kitchenware requested on July 23, 1943, were shipped as requested. Goods, which were identified as belonging to her husband (File 442) were sold at auction for the net sum of \$18.64, which has been credited to his account. The following items, received at 992 Powell Street, in May, 1942, have not been accounted for: a bed, a gramophone, a dresser, 3 beds, a cross-cut saw and a mirror.

Mrs. FUJIMURA reported 16 \$10.00 War Savings Certificates in her own possession. These were apparently the property of her husband. At any rate, on October 1, 1942, she sent 16 \$10.00 Certificates to this office when this office requested that Certificates belonging to her husband (then an internee) be sent to us. The 16 \$10.00 War Savings Certificates were returned to Taichiro FUJIMURA on December 30, 1942, after his release from internment.

Mrs. FUJIMURA declared a bank account with the Royal Bank, Main & Hastings, Vancouver. This was not under the control of the Custodian.

She declared a Japan & Canada Trust Savings account, but as her name does not appear on the list of depositors as at December 31, 1942, it would appear that she must have withdrawn her funds.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

CHattel SUMMARY

On March 18, 1942, Taichiro FUJIMURA signed a declaration to the Custodian. He was evacuated the following day. His wife, File 8121, signed a declaration on May 4, 1942, a week before her evacuation.

Mr. FUJIMURA listed his chattels in general terms "contents of 3-roomed dwelling, including:" as is shown on the Chattel Schedule. Mrs. FUJIMURA listed the chattels in detail - see 2nd column Schedule.

An inventory (unsigned) dated June 6, 1942 is on file. It is shown by File Q/90 that this inventory was made up by the manager of the B. C. Pulp & Paper Company, Woodfibre, and sent to this office along with other inventories of goods stored in one of the company's buildings. Union Steamship Co. shipping bill of June 9, 1942, shows shipment of the items inventoried to Vancouver. These goods were stored at 992 Pwail Street and are listed on Inventory 157. All three lists agree reasonably well.

Neither of the inventories nor the shipping bill mention the sewing machine declared by Mr. FUJIMURA, the 2 stoves declared by Mrs. FUJIMURA nor the garden and carpenter tools declared by Mr. FUJIMURA. It is assumed therefore that all these items were disposed of in some manner by the owners.

On July 23, 1943, Mrs. FUJIMURA signed a Release requesting shipment of two boxes of dishes, pots and pans. The file does not reveal whether or not shipment was made.

Goods, identified as the property of Taichiro FUJIMURA were sold at Vancouver Auction 29. Among the items were "ceramics" sold for \$4.70, a guitar sold for \$4.50 and a drum sold for 75 cents. None of these items were declared, and none can be identified from the inventories on the two files. We are assuming that these items were packed in some of the crates and boxes received, in the name of Taichiro FUJIMURA, from Woodfibre. The remaining items sold for this man were among those listed as being shipped from Woodfibre. The net proceeds from this auction sale were \$18.64.

The following items, which were inventoried at Woodfibre, do not appear on the shipping bill - Festival dolls.
