



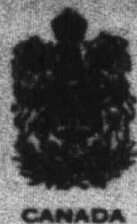

During the time when he is a patient in that Institution the Attorney-General, for whom this office acts, is ex-officio committee of his estate and as such is charged with the duty of its administration.

Your letter dated December 3, 1946, addressed to Mr. Juro Yoshikawa, c/o Essondale Mental Hospital, has been redirected to this office for my attention.

Your letter lists various assets due the estate of Juro Yoshikawa and in this regard I would be pleased to receive your cheque for the full amount on hand, along with an itemized statement as included in your letter to the patient.

A Statement of Liabilities should also be forwarded giving a brief outline of how the liability was incurred. Upon receipt, consideration will be given to settling any claim in full or in part against the estate of the patient.

Again referring to your letter to the patient you have listed under "Bonds, Shares, etc.", a Victory Bond \$50.00 and War Savings Certificates (16), and under "Life Insurance", a policy with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Company for \$1,000.00. If you have any knowledge as to where these assets are now located would you kindly advise me accordingly.

I note that the patient has previously stated to you in his declaration that he owns no Real Property.

This file has been up for review and we take advantage of this opportunity to give you a brief resume of the contents thereof.

Real Property: In the Custodian "JP" declaration form signed by you on the 4th May, 1942, you stated that you owned no Real Property.

Personal Property: Our records show the chattels declared by you to have been moved from Woodfibre to Vancouver for better storage. Some of these were shipped to you in July, 1943; some were sold at Custodian auctions at different times, the net proceeds being credited to your account; and some were discarded as unsaleable.

Bills Receivable: Refund of 1% wage deductions made during the period, January/June, 1941, was collected by this office and credited to your account in the sum of \$6.46.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: A Victory Bond (\$50.00) and War Savings Certificates (16) declared by you remained in your possession and did not come under the administration of this office.

Life Insurance: You declared a Manufacturers Life Insurance policy for \$1000.00, which remained in your possession and did not come under our administration.

Liabilities: Under date of March 17th, 1942, a claim of \$4.05 was filed against you on behalf of the O. Kondo Company. This debt is still outstanding in that Company's books and if it is correct we would suggest that you authorize us to pay it to the debit of your account.

Funds: There is a balance of \$40.48 standing at the credit of your account, of which the following is an extract:

Would you kindly arrange with Mr. Fisher?

The items received from Woodfibre on the husband's file (Lot 114 of May 25th, 1942) are fairly well accounted for by auction sales with the following exceptions.
