
Please note that the above has been repatriated to Japan. At the time of repatriation, the following transactions took place:

I am in receipt of your letter of December 29, 1943, regarding my account of \$60.00 with Dr. Caple. This is the correct amount.

At present, I am not at all in position to meet this bill. I have been working till 23rd of the last month, under B. C. Security Commission with the average income of \$50.00 monthly. This was hardly enough to support my family of four. Furthermore, I have been bothered with neuralgia. Dr. Kamitakahara of B. C. S. C. orders not to work.

I have all the intentions of paying this bill but at the present, I regret I cannot meet this bill.
