This 48-year old Millhand, a Japanese Nation, from Woodfibre, B. C., signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on May 4th, 1942.

He was evacuated on May 12th, 1943.

He declared his wife to be living in Japan.

The following is a summary of the contents of this file as disclosed by a review made today.

Real Property: None.

Chattels: None.

Accounts Receivable: Refund of 15 wage deductions, made during the period, January/June, 1941, (\$6.34) was collected and credited to this account and Evacuee advised.

Bonds, Shares, etc.: Victory Bonds (\$50.00) and War Savings Certificates (\$160.00) declared to be in his possession were so left.

Bank Accounts: A balance of \$400.00 declared to be in a Savings Account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings Sts., Vancouver, was not disturbed.

Life Insurance: None.

Liabilities: A claim of \$9.18, filed on behalf of M. Furuya Company, was rejected by alleged Debtor and claimant was so advised. There is no evidence of any other liability in this file.

Funds: There is a balance of \$6.34 standing at the credit of this account at the present time.
