PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

CHATELS: The above, who made his declaration to the Custodian on May 4th, 1942, and was evacuated on October 3rd, 1942, declared the following goods:

1 Kitchen table	1 Carpet
1 " chair	1 Bicycle
1 Heater	1 Trunk (clothing)
1 Bureau	1 Wardrobe
1 Bed & mattress	1 Washing machine
	Kitchenware

All of the above were stated to be stored at 130 West 1st Ave. When our investigators endeavoured to locate this address, they found an empty lot and were informed by the purchasers next door that the cabins on this now vacant lot had been demolished by order of the city authorities; furthermore that the windows in these cabins had been broken and even the plumbing removed by thieves before the cabins had been demolished. It is doubtful if the Japanese occupants of these low tenement cabins had chattels of any value, and if they did, they probably sold them or took them with them at the time of their evacuation. The writer and Mr. D.A. Smith had extreme difficulty in clarifying the issue and made repeated efforts in different directions before we were able to get any information in this industrial neighbourhood.

WAR SAVINGS CERTIFICATES: The above declared \$25.00 in War Savings Certificates in his own possession, which did not come under the control of the Custodian.

BANK ACCOUNT: The above declared a savings account in the Bank of Montreal, Main & Hastings Branch, Vancouver in the amount of \$1400.00 and also an account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Main & Hastings, in the sum of \$300.00. These accounts did not come under the control of the Custodian.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: We received the sum of \$25.89 from the Income Tax Department for the above, being a refund of his national defense tax for 1942. This amount is his total credit with this office.

The file reveals that the above owned no specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.



Your file has been reviewed and it is noted that you declared chattels at 130 West 1st Ave., Vancouver. Our investigators called at that address with the purpose of removing the chattels to Custodian warehouse, only to be informed that you had sold your chattels or removed them elsewhere.

You declared \$1400.00 savings account with the Bank of Montreal and \$300.00 with the Royal Bank of Canada, but these funds did not come under the control of the Custodian.

We received the sum of \$25.69 for you from the Income Tax Department, being a refund of your national defense tax for 1942. This amount was placed to the credit of your account with this office.
