electric sewing machine - Not inventoried by Custodian and it is possible that Mr. and Mrs. TOYONAGA took this with them when they were evacuated.

Wife declared tables - none inventoried by the Custodian.

With the exception of the sewing machine and tables not found by the Custodian and the trunks which were not sold although the contents were, it would appear that everything declared by Mr. and Mrs. TOYONAGA has been accounted for. The chattels as listed on Chattel Schedule were sold at Vancouver auctions #3, 9, 56 and 97 for the total net sum of \$73.73 and this sum credited to the account of Mr. TOYONAGA.

Mr. TOYONAGA's account was also credited with the sum of \$27.33, being a refund of National Defense Tax for 1942.
