This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 5, 1942. He was evacuated on August 22, 1942.

In his declaration he reported household effects left at Britannia Beach, B.C., which effects were also declared by his wife. Of these effects 3 boxes of kitchenware and a box of carpenter's tools were shipped to this man and the remainder of the chattels were sold and the proceeds credited to the account of this man's wife, File No. 11854.

He reported a \$50.00 Victory Bond and twenty-four \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession. He reported a bank account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Vancouver with a balance of \$1,200.00. He reported a \$1,000.00 life insurance policy with the Sun Life Assurance Co., the policy in his own possession. None of these items came under the control of this office.

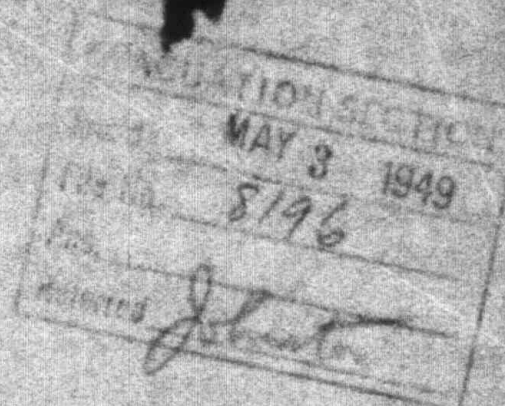
