Dear Sir:

Replying to your letter of September 21st re Minoru Adachi #09038.

We beg to advise that the Japanese formerly living here stored their household goods in the Japanese Hall at Paldi, but just what was stored in this hall, the Company has no way of knowing, as we were not given a list or a record of each individual's personal property.

The understanding with Mr. T. Urabe, the Japanese Foreman while working for this Company, was that they could store their chattels in the hall and we would ship out anything they ordered, if it was possible. Since then, we have shipped considerable items to them as per instructions from your office. Records of which we have here. But as to what is left in the hall, we have no record.

We shipped for M. Adachi six pieces as per your order dated July 27th signed by Mr. J. A. Rose of the B. C. Security Commission.

GENERAL SUMMARY

File 8222

Re: Kazuma YONEMURA, Reg.No. 09028

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 8, 1942. He was evacuated on June 29, 1942.

In his declaration, he reported quite a large quantity of household effects, which he listed in detail, and he stated these were in the Japanese Hall, Mayo, B. C. Two beds and springs, mattresses, clothing, drapes, cushions and some other small items were sold and the proceeds from the sale were credited to the account of this man, in the amount of \$7.01. In Custodian Suspense Account there are funds derived from the sale of goods reported to be owned by this man or his father, but as neither man had declared the items sold, we do not know that these are the property of the men concerned. The funds are being left in Suspense until the Yonemura family supply evidence of ownership. It is thought that some chattels unaccounted for on file may have been shipped.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$5.30 received as refund of one per cent wage deductions for 1941. This money was remitted to him on March 6, 1944.
