PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

Re: KUWABARA, Yoshiko Lois (Mrs. E. H.) Reg. No. 10797.
formerly NAKASUJI.

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 2, 1942 and was evacuated on May 22, 1942.

CHATELS: She declared a large quantity of books to be left with a storage company. This was evidently Bowman Storage as the file reveals a letter to that company, dated July 21, 1943, releasing for shipment two boxes of books, which we presume were duly received by the Japanese.

She also declared a muskrat Fur Coat left with the Famous Suit & Cloak Co. The Famous advised that the coat was shipped on September 26, 1942.

After her marriage to Dr. Kuwabara, she sent in a chattel release for a crated sewing machine stored with Bowman Storage. The file does not carry evidence of shipment, but, in the absence of any further request we presume shipment was made.

BONDS: She declared that she owned \$30.00 worth of War Savings Certificates and one \$50.00 Victory Bond of 1942 issue, all in her possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

BANK

ACCOUNT: She carried a Savings Account with the Royal Bank of Canada, Main and Hastings branch, in the amount of \$100.00, which was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

The file reveals no property other than that mentioned above.
