



CHATELS: The above registered May 8, 1942 and was evacuated May 22, 1942. She declared chattels at 215 Gore Avenue, but as this address was crowded with chattels unmarked with owners' names, the segregation was accomplished with the utmost difficulty. As several articles were not found or identified as hers, it is possible that Mrs. IBUKI sold some of her chattels prior to evacuation, or they were so mixed with chattels belonging to other Japanese as to defy our efforts to segregate and identify. This leaves the possibility that some of her chattels were removed and sold under the name of some other individual. The articles removed from this address were very poor quality. They were sold for the net sum of 11.05 at public auction.

No other personal property or assets were declared by this person.
