



Re: Mr. Yoshiichi YOSHIMOTO

At the time Mr. Yoshimoto registered his assets with the Custodian he declared to us that he had been in your employ.

In order that our records may be complete we would appreciate your advising us whether or not Mr. Yoshimoto has maintained an account with you and if so, whether the account has been active and the present status of said account.

A Mr. Ichiro Uchida has declared to us that on April 17, 1942 certain stocks belonging to his wife and valued at something in excess of \$300.00 had been handed to Mr. Yoshimoto with instructions that they be sold. Subsequently Mr. Uchida advised us that he and his wife had received no word from Mr. Yoshimoto nor had they received payment for the stocks.

If you have any knowledge of this matter, we would appreciate your informing us immediately.

It is perhaps unnecessary for us to advise you that the Custodian would appreciate your contacting this office before remitting funds to any individual of the Japanese race evacuated from the Protected Area.

Dear Sir:

It is our pleasure to inform you that we have obtained for you from the Provincial Collector in Vancouver cheque for \$22.47 representing refund of 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ wage deductions for the first six months of 1941. This amount has been credited to your account with us.

We also wish to inform you that we have received a claim for \$3.00 from Dr. M. Uchida against "Mr. Yoshiichi Yoshimoto, Steveston, B. C." If this claim is against you and if you acknowledge the correctness of it, we would appreciate your so advising us in order that we may effect settlement on your behalf.

We do not appear to have received any reply from you as yet to our letter to you dated August 22nd in connection with Mr. Ichiro Uchida whose wife, on April 17, 1942, turned over to you oil stocks to the amount of \$328.00 for liquidation.

We would appreciate your providing us with your comments in connection with the three points mentioned in this letter.
