PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

July 27, 1946.

Re: Yukio NIIYA, Reg. No. 09210

This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 9, 1942. He was evacuated on September 21, 1942.

In his declaration he reported various tools, carpenter and woodcutting, left at the Japanese Hall, Paldi, B.C. With the exception of a bucking saw which was shipped to him in October, 1942, these were sold at auction in Duncan on March 15, 1942, together with some articles declared by his wife, File No. 8030 and the net proceeds of \$17.26 were credited to his account. A carton containing drapes was shipped to Vancouver for auction and the net proceeds from the sale of these drapes in the amount of 67 cents was credited to his account. As the amount received from auction sales is included in the amount being paid on a claim against his wife we are not transferring the proceeds of chattels declared by the wife to her account.

He reported six \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession, a personal accident and sickness policy with the Tanaka Insurance Agency and a 20-year endowment policy for \$1,000.00 with the Manufacturers Life Insurance Co. These items did not come under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$5.24 received as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941.
