This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 9, 1942. She was evacuated on September 3, 1942.

In her declaration, Mrs. Kobayashi reported four boxes of effects. On August 10, 1942, she signed a Custodian Release for these goods, and it is assumed that these were taken with her upon her evacuation.

Mrs. Kobayashi reported a debt owing to her by Mr. K. Nakamura, 446 E. Cordova St., Vancouver, in the amount of \$130.00. This claim was settled in full for \$80.00, which, with Mrs. Kobayashi's approval, was credited to the account of her husband, file 14788.

The net proceeds from the sale of a motor-vehicle belonging to Mrs. Kobayashi's husband was in error credited to her account, but was later transferred to the account of her husband.

This file reveals no real property interest.
