This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 9, 1942. He was evacuated on June 29, 1942.

In his declaration he reported eight \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his own possession, and a \$2,000.00 policy with the Monarch Life Insurance Co. These items did not come under the control of this office.

This man was part owner of a 1937 Nash Sedan, together with his brother. Net proceeds of sale of this car were credited to the account of his brother, File No. 8016, on instructions of this man in his letter of January 11, 1944.
