This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 9, 1942. He was evacuated on September 29, 1942.

In his declaration he reported books left at #5 Storage, Cumberland, B.C. These were shipped to him on June 4, 1942.

He reported sporting goods left at #118 Cumberland, Matt Brown having the key. This house was broken into on two occasions and these articles were missing, and no trace has since been found of them.


He reported \$130.00 in War Savings Certificates in his own possession. These did not come under the control of this office. He reported a \$1,000.00 endowment policy with the Dominion of Canada General Insurance Co. in his own possession. This did not come under the control of this office.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$4.33 received as refund of 1% wage deduction for 1941. This amount was remitted to FUJIMOTO on March 3, 1944.

The account of this man was credited with the sum of \$10.51 as proportionate share of the assets of the Royston Savings Association.
