This file reveals Mrs. UCHIYAMA owned no real property in any protected area of B. C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS:

Mrs. UCHIYAMA made her declaration to the Custodian on May 9/42 and was evacuated on June 1/42. She declared the following, at 8814 Selkirk St., in care of Mr. SUZUKI.

6 chairs	1 box of school books
1 table	1 box of tools
3 beds and springs	1 chesterfield
3 fishing nets, 2 lead lines and 1 cork line	

The fishing nets were also declared by her husband.

Mr. Yonesaku FUJIOKA, File 10228, also had chattels and fishing nets and equipment stored at a building at the rear of 8814 Selkirk St. Chattels and some nets were found at this address tagged with the name of FUJIOKA, but apparently none with the name of Mr. or Mrs. UCHIYAMA.

We wrote to Mr. FUJIOKA on Dec. 21/44 sending him copies of three auction sheets and stating that the UCHIYAMA'S also had goods stored at 8814 Selkirk. We sent a copy of this letter to Mr. UCHIYAMA. Mr. FUJIOKA did not reply to this letter but we did receive a letter from Mr. UCHIYAMA dated Jan. 6/45 in which he said that the fishing nets left at 8814 Selkirk were tagged with his name, but he did not mention the household goods at all. It would therefore appear that they took the household goods with them but did leave the nets. No trace of nets belonging to Mr. UCHIYAMA were found by the Custodian.

BANK
ACCOUNT:

She declared a bank account in the Royal Bank of Canada, Marpole Branch, in the sum of \$300.00. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE
INSURANCE:

She declared a Prudential Insurance policy in her own name in the sum of \$500.00 and policies on the lives of her children for the same amount. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

A credit appearing on this file for arrears of wages from the ^{Canada} Continental Daily News in the sum of \$10.50 really belongs to her son Masahi. A file has been started for him and a requisition is being made to transfer this money from the account of the mother to the account of Masahi.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

Dear Sir:

On reviewing your file relative to chattels it has been found that besides the Arimas, Mr. and Mrs. Sasaki Uchiyama also declared chattels as being left at 8814 Selkirk Street.

When removing the goods from the above address to auction none were found marked with the name Uchiyama, therefore the chattels were sold at public auction in your name and the proceeds credited to your account. Most of the auction sheets covering the goods removed from 8814 Selkirk Street and sold at public auction in your name were forwarded to you on August 24, 1945. A few items were sold subsequent to that date and the auction sheets covering such goods are now enclosed and we shall be glad if you will kindly examine all the auction sheets carefully and let us know if any of the goods shown thereon belonged to Mr. and Mrs. Uchiyama.

If none of the goods sold belonged to the Uchiyamas and in order that the funds from the sale of all chattels may be credited to the correct account, we shall be glad if you will confirm that all the goods shown on the above-mentioned auction sheets (with the exception of those mentioned by your daughter, Aya, in her letter of November 12, 1945 as belonging to the Arimas) were your property.

Your prompt attention to this matter will be appreciated.
